Host team – The Dauphin Kings

- The Dauphin Kings finished first in the Sher-Wood Division of the MJHL and fifth overall in the CJHL. The 2009-10 season was record breaking for the Kings with a franchise-high 50 wins in the regular season. The Kings face the Neepawa Natives in the first round of playoffs. - The last Host team to win the RBC Cup was the Weyburn Red Wings of the SJHL in 2005. In 2007, host team Prince George Spruce Kings of the BCHL made it to the final game.
- 1992 was the last time the event was hosted by the MJHL-St James Canadians.
- The last MJHL host team to win was the Selkirk Steelers in 1974.

2010 RBC Cup – Host Committee Legacy Plan

The 2010 RBC Cup is hosted by a volunteer host committee in partnership with the Manitoba Junior Hockey League, Hockey Manitoba and Hockey Canada. The volunteer committee in Dauphin has an exceptional plan in place to leave a great legacy behind from the hosting of this National Championship.

One hundred percent all profits from the 2010 RBC Cup will be broken down amongst the following groups through the efforts of the volunteer host committee in Dauphin, Manitoba.

Dauphin Joint Recreation Commission

A percentage of net profits would go to the Dauphin Joint Recreation Commission (DJRC) for arena enhancements to Credit Union Place and the Rotary Arena. DJRC is operated by an independent Board of Directors that manages the recreation facilities, parks and green spaces in the community of Dauphin.

Dauphin Kings

A percentage of net profits would go to the Dauphin Kings for facility upgrades including dressing room improvements and training equipment.

Youth Development

A percentage would go to the Vermillion Park upgrades which would include a splash park and / or playground equipment. This park provides access to free recreation for all youth.

Special Event Fund

A percentage would be provided to Dauphin Economic Development & Tourism to establish a special event fund. This fund would be used as seed money for the development of future bid packages to allow the community the ability to attract more events to Dauphin such as the RBC Cup.

Minor Hockey Legacy Fund

A percentage of net profits will be put towards a legacy fund for equipment and education bursaries for Minor Hockey. This will be a trust fund that is managed by the Dauphin Community Foundation.
